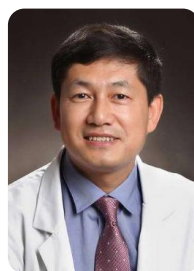

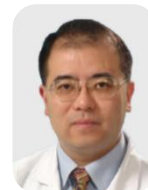

- The abstract should be no more than 1,000 words (excluding the title) .
- The submission file should be prepared in Microsoft Word format (doc or docx) .
- Written in Arial font, 12 pt.
- The abstract should include:
  - ❑ Title
  - ❑ Authors and institution (affiliation)
  - ❑ Materials and methods
  - ❑ Results
  - ❑ Conclusion
  - ❑ Table and figure (if applicable) with captions
  - ❑ Proof of ethical approval letter (including patients' informed consent if applicable)
- Format the abstract file to fit in two pages of A4 (including table or figure attached) .
- Please underline the name of the presenter and provide a phone number and e-mail for correspondence .
- Any submission must disclose funding sources and include a conflict-of-interest disclosure statement.
- Submission **deadline: August 30 , 2025**
